The following procedures will be used for repeating a course for substandard grades.

- 1) A student may choose to repeat any high school course for a higher grade.
 - a. The original grade will not be changed or removed from the transcript.
 - b. The point value from the original course will not be removed or altered. The GPA of the repeated course will be averaged to the student's cumulative grade.
 - c. Quality points will not be awarded for course repetition.
- 2) Students may choose to enroll in Acellus Credit Make-up recovery courses as another way of course repetition for substandard grades.
 - a. Students will meet with the counselor or administration to enroll in Acellus credit recovery courses.
 - b. The GPA of Acellus courses will not be averaged to the student's cumulative grade.
 - c. Quality points will not be awarded for Acellus Credit make-up.
- 3) A student may choose to repeat a college course if they are concurrently enrolled at a partner approved college or university.
 - a. If a student chooses to repeat a college level course, they will do so as long as the original class has been paid for in full.
 - b. The GPA from the original grade will not be altered. The GPA of the repeated course will be averaged to the student's cumulative grade.
 - c. Quality points will not be awarded for course repetition.
- 4) Exceptions will be made on a case by case basis.
- 5) Students may appeal any decision about the repetition of courses to the Principal or DHPH Executive Director.
