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- 1. All courses that students take at Pueblo Community College, Colorado State University-Pueblo, or University of Colorado, Colorado Springs, will have transitional credit value agreed upon by DHPH for the transfer of high school credit as identified by a MOU.
- 2. A list of transferable credit will be provided to students and parents to define classes that are transferrable high school credit.
- 3. All transferrable courses taken at the post-secondary level can be reviewed on the specific college/university websites.
- 4. Appeals can be brought to the Principals of each building or the Executive Director of CHPA regarding changes or conflicts in inter-institutional issues.
- 5. Learning outcomes for new programs or curriculum presented by the colleges or universities will be reviewed by the Principal for course equivalency. The Principal will determine whether a course is deemed appropriate for transfer, and will provide evidence to the CHPA Board of Directors for approval.
- 6. An MOU for course transfer and articulation will be provided to ensure a clear ongoing transfer structure.

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
