1. All courses that students take at Pueblo Community College, Colorado State University-Pueblo, or University of Colorado, Colorado Springs, will have transitional credit value agreed upon by DPHH for the transfer of high school credit as identified by a MOU.
2. A list of transferable credit will be provided to students and parents to define classes that are transferrable high school credit.
3. All transferrable courses taken at the post-secondary level can be reviewed on the specific college/university websites.
4. Appeals can be brought to the Principals of each building or the Executive Director of CHPA regarding changes or conflicts in inter-institutional issues.
5. Learning outcomes for new programs or curriculum presented by the colleges or universities will be reviewed by the Principal for course equivalency. The Principal will determine whether a course is deemed appropriate for transfer, and will provide evidence to the CHPA Board of Directors for approval.
6. An MOU for course transfer and articulation will be provided to ensure a clear ongoing transfer structure.
