Board members shall be notified of significant Chávez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy (CHPA) sponsored functions, including ceremonial and celebratory events. Board members will be formally recognized by staff and participate at such venues.

Board members may attend community events or meetings related to the CHPA mission as authorized by the Board. Expenses for such representation will be at the expense of CHPA including mileage reimbursement permitted by law. Staff will provide the event sponsor with Director background information for purpose of recognition.

Board members may participate at CHPA auxiliary fundraising events at the Board members' personal expense. Board members are encouraged to become donors to CHPA and will be recognized as contributors.

A Board member may attend fee-based employee CHPA events out of personal interest or as a community member at the Board member's personal expense. No formal recognition by staff is provided for activities of this type.

A Board member may attend non-CHPA sponsored events at the invitation of an outside sponsoring group out of personal interest or as a community member at personal expense. As such, a Board member does not represent the Board, nor does attendance imply Board endorsement of the venue and/or its related activities. Formal recognition, if any, is the responsibility of the sponsoring group.
