Chavez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy shall be free from all state and federal illegal drugs and from the unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol by students and employees. The unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in all facilities under the control and use of CHPA and/or school sanctioned functions; with the exception of medical marijuana use by students according to Board Policy 2080. Any student or employee who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action, (consistent with local, state, or federal law), which may include referral to an appropriate rehabilitation program, suspension, demotion, expulsion or dismissal.
