The Executive Director shall ensure that CHPA has and implements a broad-based comprehensive, systematic, and integrated system of planning that involves appropriate segments of the CHPA community and is supported by institutional effectiveness research. The Executive Director shall ensure the Board has an opportunity to assist in developing the CHPA mission and goals for the comprehensive plans.

The planning system shall include plans required by the Board, including but not limited to:

- Long Range Educational Master Plan, which shall be updated periodically as deemed necessary by the governing Board
- Facilities Plan
- Enrollment Management
- Technology
- Professional Development

The Executive Director shall inform the Board about the status of planning and various plans. The Executive Director shall submit those plans for which Board approval is required.
