The administration and professional staff shall devise a grading and/or assessment system for evaluating and recording student progress and to measure student performance in conjunction with the school's academic standards. The records and reports of individual students shall be kept in a form meaningful to parents/guardians as well as teachers. The grading/assessment system shall be uniform school-wide at comparable grade levels.

The Board of Directors of Chávez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy delegates the authority to the CEO in conjunction with principals and with input from faculty to approve the grading, reporting, and assessment systems.

The Board of Directors recognizes that classroom grading and/or assessment systems, however effective, are somewhat subjective as well as objective. The Board of Directors urges all faculty members to conduct student evaluations in a professional manner.
