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The Executive Director along with the building principals shall establish standards of conduct and procedures for the imposition of discipline on students in accordance with the requirements for due process for the federal and state law and regulations. The procedures shall clearly define the standards of conduct and procedures utilized when disciplinary action is necessary including but not limited to the suspension or expulsion of a student.

The Chavez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy Board shall consider any recommendation from the Executive Director for expulsion. The board shall consider an expulsion recommendation in executive session unless the student requests that the matter be considered in a public meeting. Final action by the Board on the expulsion shall be taken at a public meeting. The final decision of the Board shall be submitted to the authorizing school district, Pueblo City Schools. The procedures shall be made available to students through the student handbook and other means. Students who violate any of the following standards for student conduct while on campus at CHPA or during off campus school sponsored activities are subject to the procedures outlined in Administrative Procedure 3050: Student Discipline.
