The Board of Directors of Chávez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy believe parental involvement and parental responsibility are important in a child's education.

Attendance: Every child who has attained the age of six years on or before August 1 of each year and is under the age of seventeen years, shall attend public school with exceptions provided by the law.

A student shall be considered truant when he or she is absent from school without a parent(s)/guardian(s) excuse, or when a student fails to arrive and/or leaves the school and/or classroom without permission.

A student, who has attained the age of six years on or before August 1 of the school year in question and is under the age of seventeen years who has four unexcused absences in any calendar month or ten unexcused absences during the reported school year, will be considered a "habitual truant" and a court petition may be filed.
