Title BP 3240 Career and Technical Educational Programs (CTE)

The Board of Directors at Chavez Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy will allow for the development of career and technical education programs (CTE) at Dolores Huerta Preparatory High.

The Board shall adopt standards for CTE which meet or exceed the state's model content standards and describe the essential knowledge and skills that students enrolled in these courses are expected to master. The course curriculum shall be aligned with adopted standards and the state's curriculum framework.

Career and Technical Education assists students, workers and lifelong learners of all ages fulfill their working potential. First and foremost it is about high school and college education that provides students with:

- Academic subject matter taught with relevance to the real world, often called contextual learning
- Employability skills, from job-related skills to workplace ethics
- Education pathways that help students explore interests and careers in the process of progressing through school
