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Chávez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy Board of Directors recognize that community service teaches students the importance of being good citizens and taking an active role in their community while supporting the school's Mission, Vision and Core Values.

A community service program will be coordinated at Dolores Huerta Preparatory High (DHPH) by the principal or designee in such a manner that it fulfills all school and state requirements necessary to obtain a community service certificate.

The minimum number of hours of community service necessary to qualify for certification is 80 hours. These hours shall be validated annually by the DHPH principal or designee and noted on the student's official transcript.

Community Service hours will not be available for any activity for which a student receives academic credit, compensation or those required by restorative justice or court order.
