Every student of Chávez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy shall have equal educational opportunities through programs offered in the school regardless of race, color, ancestry, creed, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, religion, national origin, marital status, disability, or need for special education services.

The concept of equal educational opportunity shall guide the Board of Directors and staff in making decisions related to school facilities, selection of educational materials, equipment, curriculum, and regulations affecting students. Students with identified physical and mental impairments that constitute disabilities shall be provided with a free appropriate public education, consistent with the requirements of federal and state laws and regulations.
