<b>Adopted</b>	June 13, 2017
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Chávez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy (CHPA) believes that student use of school's technology is an essential tool for student learning. However, the use of school technology, the Internet and electronic communications demands personal responsibility and an understanding of the acceptable and unacceptable uses of such tools.

Failure to follow the use procedures as outlined in AP 3350 Student Technology Use may result in the loss of these essential tools and restitution for costs associated with damages, and may result in school disciplinary action, including suspension or expulsion, and/or legal action. CHPA may deny, revoke or suspend access to school technology or close accounts at any time.

Students and parents/guardians shall be required to sign the school's acceptable use agreement.
