**Title** BP 3410 Academic/Extracurricular/Co-curricular Lettering

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The Board of Directors of Chávez-Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy supports the concept that a wide variety of extracurricular, and co-curricular activities should be made available to students. Extra-curricular activities are defined as activities that are not part of the required curriculum, outside the regular course of study but under the supervision of the school. Athletics and esport activities are considered extra-curricular. Co-curricular activities are defined as complementary activities to the official curriculum, as a civic or service activity outside the classroom. Mariachi or Folkloric programs would be considered co-curricular activities. Students who demonstrate excellence in these activities should be recognized for their efforts. Therefore, the Board of Directors allows for the building principals to recognize students through lettering as a way to show distinction in academics, extra-curricular and co-curricular activities.
