Chavez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy (CHPA) may employ currently enrolled students in a part-time capacity during non-scheduled school days throughout the calendar year. Compensation for student workers will be paid in compliance with the minimum wage rate established by the State of Colorado.

Students may be hired in the following areas within the organization:

- Custodial Department
- Clerical Support
- Academic Support

Students must be 16 years of age according the Colorado Department of Labor. Students must apply and undergo the CHPA interview process for any position for which they are interested.

Student workers cannot work during scheduled school days and hours for which they are enrolled and expected to attend academic classes.
